**New Book Coming!**

The DBS Executive Committee, in its business session, voted to publish another of Dean Burgon's books. This time, *The Revision Revised*. Though our present reprint, *The Last Twelve Verses of Mark*, is only 400 pages, this new

project of *The Revision Revised* will involve about 640 pages. This will be an ambitious project for which we request your earnest prayers. We expect to begin work on this September 1, 1996.

**Demand for the Book**

*The Revision Revised* will be printed in a HARDBACK cover to make it more permanent for students and teachers to use. The book was reprinted by Conservative Classics and by Dr. Hobbs. It is still in demand and is used in several Bible-believing colleges as a textbook. Let us know of your interest. The book has three parts: (1) The errors of the English Revised Version and superiority of the King James Bible; (2) The errors of the Greek text of Westcott and Hort; and (3) the errors of the THEORY behind the text of Westcott and Hort. These subjects are still pertinent today.

Dean Burgon has, as usual, presented a scholarly and yet spiritually uplifting defense of the Traditional Greek New Testament Text and the King James Bible on which it is based.
