## July DBS--Changed To Kingston, TN!

### Kingston, TN Change!

We are very sorry to announce that we cannot hold our 19th Annual Dean Burgon Society Meeting in Asheville, NC, this year, but must change it to Kingston, Tennessee. The reason for this change is that the Asheville church which is being constructed will not meet its projected schedule prior to JULY 9-10, 1997, for the DBS meetings.

### New DBS Location

The host for our July 9-10, 1997, DBS Meeting will be the CALVARY BAPTIST CHURCH in Kingston, Tennessee whose Pastor is Dr. Ray Bearden. The church's location is the corner of Interstate 40 and Kentucky St. It is on Exit #352 on I-40. Kingston is about 30 miles west of KNOXVILLE, TN. Dr. Bearden graciously offered to step in when it was learned that Dr. Bob Doom's church in Asheville, NC, had to cancel. 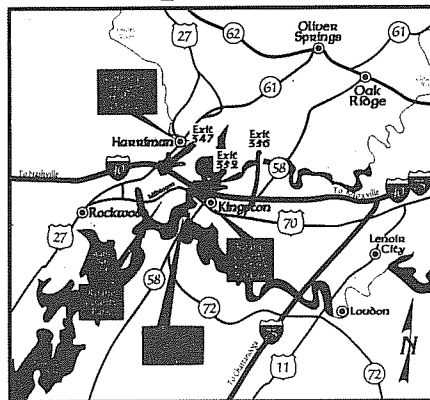
### Church Dress Code

Pastor Bearden's church has a strict dress code for all of its services. I told him I would inform our Dean Burgon Society. Appropriate attire is requested while at the meetings. You'll notice on the map above that the city of KINGSTON is off Interstate 40 at Exit #352. It is about 30 miles west of KNOXVILLE, TENNESSEE.

### Suggested DBS Motel

Pastor Bearden suggests that we use as our HEADQUARTERS MOTEL the HOLIDAY INN OF HARRIMAN. It is about four miles from the church. It is at Exit #347 on Interstate 40. The Pastor recommends it as the best around

there for our purposes though, as always, everyone can stay wherever they desire. I found out (3/21/97) that the normal cost per room at the Holiday Inn is \$51.00 for one and \$56.00 for two. Dr. Bearden told me that if you tell them you are with THE DEAN BURGON SOCIETY MEETING, you will be charged only \$45.00 for two per day! That \$6.00 to \$11.00/day difference is an excellent savings for us. The cost of the room includes a fine "Continental" breakfast at no extra cost!!

### Booking Your Rooms

If you wish to make a room reservation for the HOLIDAY INN OF HARRIMAN, TN and receive this special discount for the DBS, you MUST dial the Harriman Holiday Inn directly at 423-882-5340 You MUST tell them you are with the Dean Burgon Society Meetings. You may request either a king size, one double or two double beds at this same price.
