Accommodations

The suggested motel which is recommended by Pastor Barnett is the Super-8 Motel. It is located at 5828 Nelson A. Miles Parkway. This road is otherwise

known as Four Mile Road. Take Exit #251 off of Interstate 75. It is about 4 or 5 miles south of Grayling, Michigan. The motel is about 1.5 miles west of the church on M-72.

To get the lowest DBS prices for this motel, or even getting a reservation at all, phone 517-348-8888 for reservations **before Tuesday, midnight, March 31, 1998.** Reserve July 21, 22, and 23 (Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday). Suppose you do not wish to stay at the Motel-8, you must still get reservations in EARLY because, as Dr. Barnett informed me, this is the busiest time of the season when hundreds of people come to the Grayling area for vacation. If you don't make plans soon, you may not find any room at all.

The Prices Offered

Though the normal prices at Super-8 are over \$50 per day, the Dean Burgon Society's special price is \$46.69 (\$50.43 with tax) for either a single person or two people. You must say you are with DBS, and again must let them know on or before MARCH 31, 1998. This Super-8 is a brand new motel and is recommended highly by Pastor Barnett.
